

Year 1 – Brian Bear's Picnic!

The stories can be read to the children following the link in the booklet.

When at school, we would normally learn the model text off by heart by acting it out before we read it written down. Therefore, when starting this new story, it is okay for parents/carers to read the story to your child with them following along with their finger. The more familiar your child becomes with the story the more they may wish to read it independently later on.

Day 1 – Monday 29th June

Read the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Today I would like you to prepare a picnic lunch with your family. Why not take your favourite Teddy along! I would love to see photographs. Please send to year1@phoenixstpeter.org

Day 2 – Tuesday 30th June

Reread the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the activity on page 5.

Day 3 – Wednesday 1st July

Reread the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the matching activity on page 6.

You could cut these out to play a pairs game to make it a bit more exciting. Remember to cut along the black lines!

Day 4 – Thursday 2nd July

Read the text on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the quiz activity on page 7.

Day 5 – Friday 3rd July

Reread the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the vocabulary task on page 8.

Day 6 – Monday 6th July

Read the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the activity on page 9. Cut out the pictures and use these to create your map. Use the time conjunctions to retell the story, you could act out the story with soft toys/dolls, write it in your own words or both!

Remember to challenge yourself!

Day 7 – Tuesday 7th July

Read the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then sing along to the song on page 10. Maybe you could make up some actions or a dance? I would love to see videos. Please send to year1@phoenixstpeter.org

Day 8 – Wednesday 8th July

Read the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the activity on page 11. If you could eat anything on your picnic, what would you take? Be as imaginative as you like!!!

Day 9 – Thursday 9th July

Read the story on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the creative task on page 12. Perhaps you could create a pattern on your picnic rug or maybe you could recreate a famous artist's work... Please send to year1@phoenixstpeter.org

Day 10 – Friday 10th July

Read the text on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then read the letter from the Troop of Monkeys on page 13. Now have a go at writing a letter from the swarm of bees or from the skinny, frightened mice? Please send to year1@phoenixstpeter.org

Day 11 – Monday 13th July

Today you are the teacher! On page 14; Curtis, Bertha and Gertie have written Brian a postcard. However, they have forgotten how to use full stops and capital letters correctly and so they need your help. Can you correct their punctuation? Remember to use a different colour pen/pencil just like I do when I mark your work.

When you have fixed the punctuation, rewrite the postcard to practice your own handwriting. Remember to make sure that each letter sits on the line!

Day 12 – Tuesday 14th July

Read the text on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then complete the activity on page 15. Use other toppings if you do not like the ones in the recipe. I had to use strawberries for the ears and nose as I am allergic to bananas!

Day 13 – Wednesday 15th July

Read the text on pages 3 & 4 or preferably listen to the video if possible. Then go on a short walk outside to collect some objects. When you get home,
